

ASCS INTERNET USAGE AGREEMENT

Guidelines of Use

Use of the Internet with All Saints Catholic School computers, either on campus or through remote access, is strictly limited to educational purposes. Each Internet user is responsible for all of the information that is sent and received under his/her name. Unique computer passwords are to be guarded and not displayed or shared with others. All Internet activity at school must strictly adhere to current copyright laws. Any unethical or illegal activities will not be allowed and will be referred to the Administrator for disciplinary action, as needed. Any Internet use in violation of any local, state, or federal law is also prohibited and is a breach of the terms and conditions of this agreement. Also, all commercial uses are strictly forbidden.

Action Resulting from Inappropriate Use

Inappropriate use or access of Internet services at All Saints Catholic School by any person will be referred to the Administrator when disciplinary action is recommended. Such disciplinary action may include but is not limited to:

- Students: Verbal or written reprimands; suspension or revocation of Internet privileges at school; detention; suspension or expulsion from school; legal prosecution
- Employees: Verbal or written reprimands; Suspension or termination of employment; legal prosecution.
- Other Adults: Supervision of or denial of Internet access at any All Saints school campus; legal prosecution.
